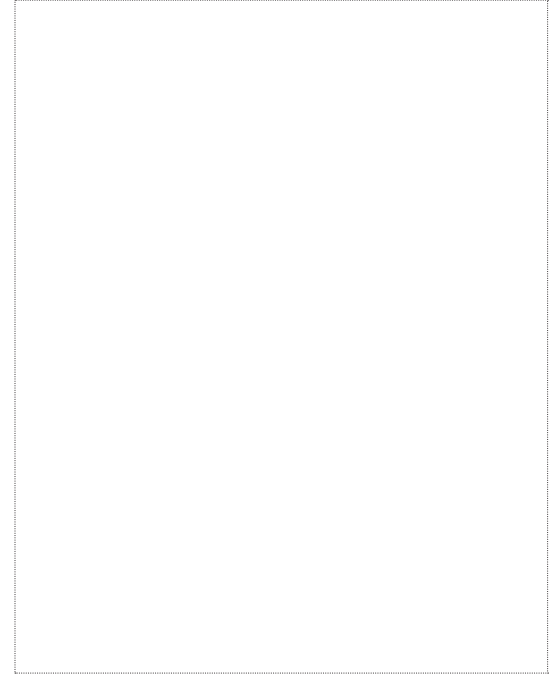


Yard Debris Quarantine

Because Japanese Beetle was found in your neighborhood of Washington County, the Oregon Department of Agriculture has designated a yard debris quarantine for this area.

To avoid further spread of the Japanese Beetle, the yard debris in your curbside roll carts will be transported directly to the Hillsboro Landfill for deep burial.



Thank you for doing your part to keep Oregon free of the Japanese Beetle!

What does the quarantine mean for residents?

Curbside Carts



What's happening to my yard debris?

Your yard debris will be taken directly to the Hillsboro Landfill and buried immediately.

Will there be any changes to my bill?

No, your bill is not affected.

How long will there be a yard debris quarantine?

From June 2017 through December 2018.

Will my collection day be the same?

Yes, your collection day remains the same.

Do I need to do anything differently to prepare my yard debris for collection?

No, there are no special instructions for preparing your yard debris. Keep it contained in your cart as usual.

Landscaping Service



What if I use a landscaping service or haul my own yard debris?

If your yard debris is removed by a landscaping service or you haul it yourself, the yard debris must be delivered to a designated drop-off site. In late June, the Oregon Department of Agriculture will be providing residents and landscapers with the address, hours of operation, and access information for the designated site. There will be no charge to drop off yard debris from the quarantine area. Feel free to contact the Oregon Department of Agriculture with any questions at the contact information below.
